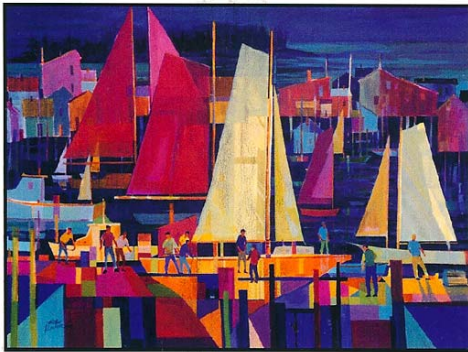

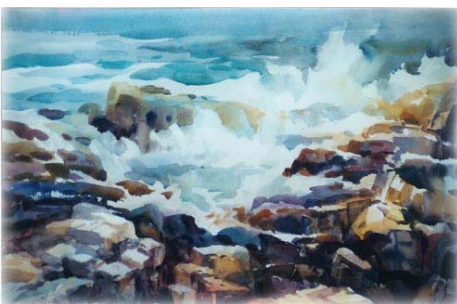

November Demo -- Carlton Plummer, Nationally- Acclaimed Artist

The Chelmsford Art Society is featuring Maine artist, **Carlton Plummer, AWS**, who will be demonstrating watercolor painting. The nationally-acclaimed artist, workshop instructor and author, has exhibited widely, both here and abroad. Well known for his flamboyant style and exciting use of color, Plummer's paintings have captured the varying moods of the Maine coast and its interior for over 40 years.

Well published, Plummer's work can be found in numerous art books and magazines here and overseas. He also wrote his own book "Create Dramatic Coastal Scenes in Watercolor." Recipient of over 200 awards, he is well

represented in many public and private collections throughout the U.S.A. and abroad. Plummer lived in Chelmsford for many years where he taught art at Chelmsford High School and U Mass Lowell, where he influenced many students. He continues to expand his creative horizons into abstraction and the world of fantasy.
