The Chelmsford Art Society is featuring artist, Tom Gill, who will demonstrate painting on September 30, 2008. A renowned area artist, Gill specializes in "impressionistic realism." In his entertaining style, he will reveal how his works are characterized by an intensity of color through vigorous brushwork and boldness of execution.

Gill was trained at the Art Institute of Boston. His work has been shown among other places at The Brush Gallery and The Concord Art **Association.** He presently has a one-man show for the month of September at the **Baak** Gallery, 35 Brattle St., Harvard Square, Cambridge, MA. and will have a one-person show for the month of November at the Rockport Art Association, 12 Main St., Rockport, MA.

Tom Gill maintains a studio at the **Western** Avenue Studios, 122 Western Ave., Lowell, MA. He also **teaches** classes at the Colleen Sgroi Gallery, Billerica, MA.

Tom Gill's painting style is inspired by John Singer Sargent, Norman Rockwell, Richard Schmid, and many others. He describes his style as impressionistic realism. Tom developed his own style using acrylic paint mostly on canvas to express his emotions, using brush strokes that are full of energy. He likes to work fast and paints figures in their own environment. He finishes his paintings spontaneously with what he calls: "slap, dashes, and dots." The result is always loose and impressive with harmonious colors that interplay with light.
